Some people (about 1 in 4000) may have seizures or black outs triggered by light flashes, such as while watching TV or playing video games, even if they have never had a seizure before.

To reduce the likelihood of a seizure when playing video games:

- 1. Sit or stand as far from the screen as possible.
- 2. Play video games on the smallest available television screen.
- 3. Do not play if you are tired or need sleep.
- 4. Play in a well-lit room.
- 5. Take a 10 to 15 minute break every hour.

WARNING - Repetitive Motion Injuries

Playing video games can make your muscles, joints or skin hurt after a few hours. Follow these instructions to avoid problems such as Tendonitis, Carpal Tunnel Syndrome or skin irritation:

- Take a 10 to 15 minute break every hour, even if you don't think you need it.
- If your hands, wrists or arms become tired or sore while playing, stop and rest them for several hours before playing again.
- If you continue to have sore hands, wrists or arms during or after play, stop playing and see a doctor.

WARNING - Battery Leakage

Leakage of battery acid can cause personal injury as well as damage to your Game Boy. If battery leakage occurs, thoroughly wash the affected skin and clothes. Keep battery acid away from your eyes and mouth. Leaking batteries may make popping sounds.

To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix used and new batteries (replace all batteries at the same time).
- Do not mix alkaline and carbon zinc batteries.
- Do not mix different brands of batteries.
- Do not use nickel cadmium batteries.
- Do not leave used batteries in the Game Boy. When the batteries are losing their charge, the power light may become dim, the game sounds may become weak, or the display screen may be blank. When this happens, promptly replace all used batteries with new batteries.
- Do not leave batteries in the Game Boy or accessory for long periods of non-use.
- Do not leave the power switch on after the batteries have lost their charge. When you finish using the Game Boy, always slide the power switch OFF.
- Do not recharge the batteries.
- Do not put the batteries in backwards. Make sure that the positive (+) and negative (-) ends are facing in the
 correct directions. Insert the negative end first. When removing batteries, remove the positive end first.
- Do not dispose of batteries in a fire.



How to connect Game Boy® Advance Game Link® Cables

Items you need

Game Boy® Advance	Equal number to the number of players
"EGG MANIA" Game Pak —————————	Equal number to the number of players
Game Link® Cables exclusively for Game Boy®	Advance
2 players —	1 Game Link® Cable
3 players ————————	2 Game Link® Cable
4 players —	3 Game Link® Cable

A Game Link® Cable that is not designed for Game Boy® Advance is being used.


The Game Link® Cable is not inserted all the way in.

Pulling out the Game Link® Cable while communicating.

The Game Link® Cables or systems are not connected correctly.

More than 5 systems are connected.

How to connect



- 1. Make sure that the power of all systems is OFF.
- 2. Then insert Game Paks into each system.
- Connect the Game Link® Cables together, and then connect them to each system.
- 4. Turn the power of all systems ON.
- Please see page 8 for directions on how to play the game.
 - * When playing with 2 or 3 players, DO NOT connect systems and Game Link® Cables that are not being used.
 - * 1P should be connected to the smaller plug of the Game Link® Cable.
- Connect the Game Link® Cables and systems referring to the illustration to the left.

 (Pay attention to the size of each plug)

Build a high tower from falling puzzle pieces, but if you leave too many gaps in your tower wall, rising water will destroy your progress!

Puzzle pieces of all shapes and sizes fall from the sky.

Jump up and catch the shape you need.

After you catch the piece you want, press the A Button to rotate it and the B Button to place it in your tower.

Stack the puzzle pieces without leaving gaps! To win, you'll need to reach the top before your opponent does!

Control Functions

L Button

Allows you to leap down to the lower sections in your tower. Use this function to fill in gaps in the lower rows near the water.

Control Pad

Up: Makes your character jump Left/Right: Moves your character left or right.

START

Pauses the game. Ends the game.



R Button

Discards unwanted pieces. Use this function to dump unwanted pieces that you accidentally caught.

A Button

Rotates puzzle pieces.

B Button

Places puzzle pieces.

Starting the Game



Insert the Game Pak into your Game Boy® Advance and turn on the power. Press START at the title screen to access the game's Main Menu options.




Tame Over



The game ends when your opponent defeats you and you are out of continues.
You can also end the game by selecting the "End Game" option while the game is paused.

EGG MANIA Basic Rules

Catch the falling puzzle pieces and stack them to build a tower!



You start the game on the ground level. As the game begins, puzzle pieces tumble from the sky.



After you catch a puzzle piece, press the A Button to rotate it into an ideal position. Press left or right on the Control Pad to move your character over the spot where you want to place the puzzle piece in your tower.




Position your character beneath the pieces and try to catch them.
Collect puzzle pieces faster by leaping up and grabbing them.



Press the B Button to place the puzzle piece

It's important to try to plug the empty gaps in your tower!



To reach the gaps below the top of your tower, stand above the gap and press the L Button to jump down to it.



After you leap down to a lower row with a gap, press the B Button to place a puzzle piece into the empty space.



If you ignore the gaps in your tower, rising water will eventually submerge and sink the leaky rows!



EGG MANIA Basic Rules

Keep an eye on the lamp and the meter!




Danger Lamp

Flashes whenever a leaky row is destroyed by rising water.




If water rises
up to a row
with a gap, the
danger lamp

...and the entire row will collapse!





If a leaky row sinks, all of the rows above it will drop a level closer to the rising water!



Wobble Meter

Indicates the overall stability of your tower.



If you build a tower with too many gapplagued rows, the meter will turn red...



...and the rows with gaps will crumble!





tems

Useful items fall among the plunging pieces. Catch them just like puzzle pieces and use them to do egg-ceptional things!



Spatula

Automatically fills in up to six gaps in your tower.



Super Boots

Increases your speed and the height of your leaps.



Thunderbolt

Stuns your opponent and knocks them off their tower!



Hammer

Demolishes any rows with gaps in your opponent's tower.
Knocks them off, too!



Bomb

Hurl this explosive weapon onto your opponent's tower before the fuse burns down!

Tutorial

Throughout the tutorial, a surprise guest explains the object of the game and how to accomplish basic tasks. Using the Control Pad and buttons, you can make the same moves as your tutor. Every button sequence is illustrated on the screen.



Practice Steps

Perfect your skills by completing this short and easy stage!

Unlike normal game modes, you don't have to worry about enemies or a time limit here. The water rises slowly and your sluggish opponent is in no hurry. All you have to do is build your tower to the top. Once you think you have it mastered, you can cancel as long as your tower is

Egg Mania

Over Easy (1 to 2 players)

Over Easy is the easiest way to play Egg Mania. You'll find that you'll have plenty of time to place falling blocks and the water oozes up slower than molasses. Beginning players can complete all eight stages in this introductory game. Once you do it, you'll be ready for the challenges in Hard Boiled.

- In 1 Pak mode, Astro is the only available character. The default sound setting on 2P side is "Silence".


Hard Boiled

(1 to 2 players)

Bomb

(1 to 2 players)

Unlike the tower building goals found in other game modes, you must demolish your opponent's tower using bombs in Bomb mode. The game starts at the top of the towers. Catch the bombs and hammers as they tumble from the top of the screen then throw them at your opponent's tower! You must destroy the other tower before your opponent ruins yours!



- In 1 Pak mode, Astro is the only available character. The default sound setting on 2P side is "Silence".

Multiplayer

You can play multiplayer matches in Over Easy, Hard Boiled and Bomb modes. Whenever you select a multiplayer contest, you'll need to designate it as a "1 Pak" or "2 Pak" contest.



1 Game Pak VS

1 Pak mode pits two players against each another on a single Game Pak and one Game Boy® Advance - In 1 Pak mode, Astro is the only available character. The default sound setting on 2P side is "Silence".



2 Game Pak VS

2 Pak mode pits two players against each another on two Game Paks (both locations) and two Game Boy® Advances.



Options

This is the default setting for the standard game.














Some of the blocks in place flash in the shape of a star. These are Trick Bricks.
