Mashing stuff!

The controls are easy—it's just ⇔ and ♠! If you want, you can use ♥ instead of ❖. What do I care?!







Ever used a steering wheel?

Hold the system tightly in both hands and tilt it left and right, like it's a steering wheel. A really boxy steering wheel! And watch out—you don't want to tilt your system the wrong way!





Be careful of your surroundings when tilting your system!

The gyro's not working!



If the gyro movements in the game don't look quite right, don't panic! Just put the system down on a flat surface and let it rest for a little while. It'll fix itself right up.

When playing this game, you may have to move the Nintendo 3DS system around. Make sure you have enough room before playing, and hold the system firmly with both hands while playing. Do not move the system with excessive force, as this could cause injuries, damage to the product, or damage to nearby objects.

You can use your stylus thingy for these games. If you don't have one of those, then just use your fingers. Just don't press too hard when you touch the screen. OK?!








Don't drop the mic!

Looking for the mic? These pictures should help.



Don't I sound great?

Modes and Stuff

Wanna play one of these modes? Go to the Main Menu and select it.



Story

To complete the story of the game, start by choosing a league, and clearing all its stages. Beat the



boss game to clear a stage.

Make too many mistakes and it's GAME OVER!



Every time you lose a microgame, you lose a life. After four mistakes, you're done! OK, not quite. If you're willing to cough up some coins, you can restart from where you left off. If you're outta cash, you gotta play the whole stage from the very beginning.

Why replay stages?



Once you've cleared a stage, you can play it over and over again... until you lose all your lives! It's a great way to earn some extra coins.



Challenge

This unlocks after you beat Story mode. You'll be able to replay all your favorite microgames, but with different variations and rules, like Split Screen or All Mixed Up! Wanna challenge a friend or enemy? Then select Battle Time (page 5).



Index

If you wanna play a microgame on repeat, this is the place to do it. After you've played a microgame in Story mode, it'll be added to the Index.



Arcade

Use your coins for chance to win in the Arcade! You can play with your prizes in the Toy Room, obviously.

Gimme that amiibo!



To try Wario's amiibo Sketch, go to the Misc. section in the Toy Room, and I will personally draw you a picture that matches whatever amiibo you tap. My artistic skills will bowl you over!

◆ You can tap up to three different amiibo every day, but each amiibo can only be tapped once a day.

I wanna hear from you!



If you select Studio in the Toy Room, you can add your voice to all the movies. You can save your versions to the SD card, so make sure you got plenty of free space.

Battle (Local Play) 🖼

If you have two systems, two game cards, and two players, you can battle it out by playing the same microgames at the same time.

Remember—it's gonna get faster and faster, and the first player to make four mistakes loses. If both players lose their last lives at the same time, then the battle goes into Sudden Death! The first player to lose a microgame loses the battle. Don't be a loser, be a winner!

Saving Data


Your progress will be automatically saved at certain intervals. For example, whenever you clear a stage, or get a new high score.

Deleting Save Data

To delete your save data, go to the Save Data screen, select the data you wish to delete. Then select Settings, and press Delete.

Be careful when deleting save data. Once the data has been deleted, the process cannot be reversed.

Data can be lost due to user action, such as repeatedly powering off and on the system or removing a Game Card or SD Card while saving. Data loss may also be caused by poor connectivity due to dirt or dust in the system's ports. Please be aware that in these cases data cannot be restored.

Sending Play Data

Sending Play Data (SpotPass) 4

While your system is in sleep mode, it will automatically search for wireless LAN access points, connect to the Internet, and transmit your anonymized Play Data to Nintendo, whether or not the game is launched. Select SpotPass from the title screen if you wish to enable or disable this function.
