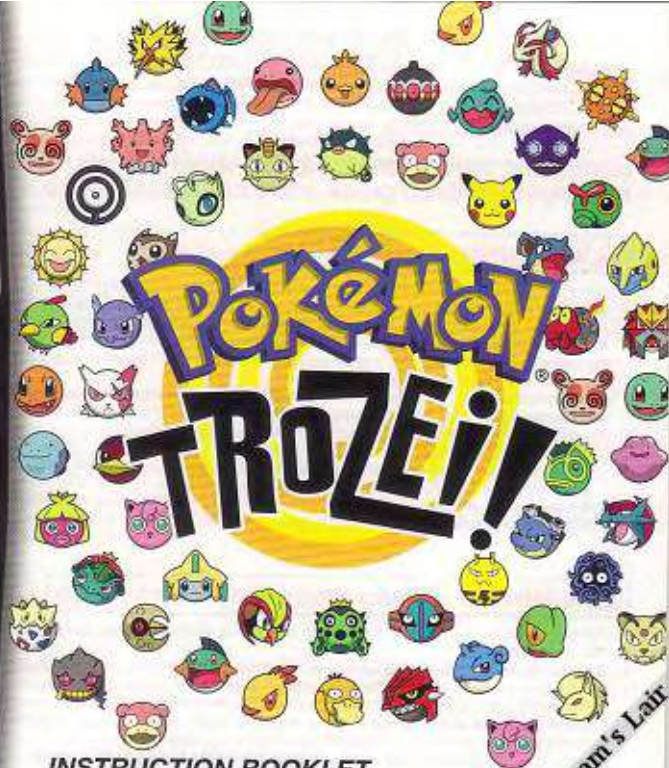

### **WARNING - Seizures**

- Some people (about 1 in 4000) may have seizures or blackouts triggered by light flashes or patterns, such as while watching TV or playing video games, even if they have never had a seizure before.
- Anyone who has had a seizure, loss of awareness, or other symptom linked to an epileptic condition should consult a doctor before playing a video game.
- Parents should watch when their children play video games. Stop playing and consult a doctor if you or your child have any of the following symptoms:

**Convulsions  
Altered vision**

**Eye or muscle twitching  
Involuntary movements**

**Loss of awareness  
Disorientation**

- To reduce the likelihood of a seizure when playing video games:
  1. Sit or stand as far from the screen as possible.
  2. Play video games on the smallest available television screen.
  3. Do not play if you are tired or need sleep.
  4. Play in a well-lit room.
  5. Take a 10 to 15 minute break every hour.

### **WARNING - Radio Frequency Interference**

The Nintendo DS can emit radio waves that can affect the operation of nearby electronics, including cardiac pacemakers.

- Do not operate the Nintendo DS within 9 inches of a pacemaker while using the wireless feature.
- If you have a pacemaker or other implanted medical device, do not use the wireless feature of the Nintendo DS without first consulting your doctor or the manufacturer of your medical device.

### **WARNING - Repetitive Motion Injuries and Eyestrain**

Playing video games can make your muscles, joints, skin or eyes hurt after a few hours. Follow these instructions to avoid problems such as tendinitis, carpal tunnel syndrome, skin irritation or eyestrain:

- Avoid excessive play. It is recommended that parents monitor their children for appropriate play.
- Take a 10 to 15 minute break every hour, even if you don't think you need it.

- If you continue to have sore hands, wrists, arms or eyes during or after play, stop playing and see a doctor.

## Basic Controls and How to Start

### Basic Controls

Basic controls involve touching or sliding your stylus on the lower screen.



- \* When you close the Nintendo DS system while playing the game, the system automatically goes into Sleep Mode. Once you open the system, the game will appear again. While you are communicating wirelessly, the system will not go into Sleep Mode.
- \* SELECT, the Control Pad, and the A, X, Y, L, and R Buttons are not used in this game.
- \* Take a rest if you get tired.
- \* You can reset the game by pressing START, SELECT, and the L and R Buttons simultaneously.

### How to Start

1. Make sure that the Nintendo DS system is turned off. Insert the Pokémon Trozei Game Card into the Game Card slot on the back of the system and push until it clicks into place. Turn the power on, and the Health and Safety Screen is displayed (shown to the right). Once you have read over the information, Touch the Touch Screen.
2. Touch the Pokémon Trozei panel on the DS Menu Screen to start the game.
  - \* If you set the DS system to Auto Mode, the game will automatically start after the Health and Safety Screen is displayed. For more information, please check the Instruction Booklet of your Nintendo DS.
  - \* In this Instruction Booklet, an orange frame surrounds the top screen and a blue frame surrounds the Touch (lower) Screen.

### Saving

Pokémon Trozei has an auto-save function. Your game data, such as your best scores and your progress in the game, will be saved automatically.

- \* You can delete all the save data by holding down the A, B, X, Y, L, and R Buttons simultaneously.
- \* When you just want to reset the Trozei Adventure data, see page 45.

## Game Menu

### Main Menu

You can select the following from the main menu screen.



#### 1 Adventure (Trozei Adventure)

One-player game. You'll proceed through the game following the story line (see page 16).

#### 2 Endless (Endless Trozei)

One-player game. Keep playing this mode to challenge your best score (see page 24).

#### 3 Battle (Trozei Battle)

Two-player game. You can battle with your friends using DS Wireless Communication (see page 28).

#### 4 Pair (Pair Trozei)

Two-player game. Challenge the best score while cooperating with a friend using DS Wireless Communication (see page 32).

#### 5 Trozei List

You can check the information of Pokémon you've Trozeid so far (see pages 38).

#### 6 Ranking Stats

You can check your best scores and rankings (see page 40).

#### 7 Agent Cafe

You can prepare for Tag Mode and check information you've exchanged (see page 42).

#### 8 Pokémon Trozei Mini

You can distribute Pokémon Trozei Mini to your friends (see page 36).

#### 9 Options

You can change your profile, select right- or left-handed play, set the PictoChat Search option, reset the adventure, and delete Ranking Stats.





## How to Play

### ✦ Let's Slide Pokémon

You can move Pokémon up, down, left, and right by touching and sliding them (you can only move Pokémon up one square).



When you slide Pokémon down, the Pokémon on the bottom drops off the lower screen and then falls from above onto the same column.



When you slide Pokémon to the right or left, the Pokémon will come back on the opposite side of the screen.



### ✦ What Is a Trozei?

Lining up 4 identical Pokémon vertically or horizontally by sliding is called a Trozei. You need to Trozei 4 or more



### ✦ What Happens When You Trozei?

When you Trozei Pokémon, they disappear from the screen. Then the Pokémon above them drop down to fill the space.



### The Bottom Screen Is the Playfield!



It is only on the playfield (bottom screen) that you can touch and slide Pokémon. The same goes for trying to get a Trozei. When you find 4 lined-up Pokémon on the top screen, you'll have to move them down to the playfield to get a Trozei.

You can't get a Trozei on the top screen.



## ✦ Trozei Chance

When you get a Trozei with 4 or more Pokémon, the screen color will change to green. This limited time is called a Trozei Chance. While the Trozei Chance lasts, you will be able to Trozei with 3 or more Pokémon. After your first Trozei during the Trozei Chance, you will be able to Trozei with 2 or more Pokémon. The Trozei Chance will last for as long as you can Trozei Pokémon.

If you line up Pokémon in the order of 4-3-2 during a Trozei Chance, these Pokémon will disappear.

## ✦ Number of Continuous Trozeis

The number of Trozeis made within a single Trozei Chance is called the Number of Continuous Trozeis.



## ✦ Number of Simultaneous Trozeis

The number of Trozeis created at the same time is called the Number of Simultaneous Trozeis.

## ✦ Score

The score is calculated as seen on the table to the right. The Score Multiplier is increased depending on the Number of Continuous Trozeis. The score is also subject to change based on which Pokémon you Trozei.

Number of Pokémon	Score
5	100 Pts
4	50 Pts
3	20 Pts
2	10 Pts

## Trozei All

When you are able to make all the Pokémon disappear from both screens, it is called a Trozei All. When you get a Trozei All, you will be awarded big bonus points.





## ✦ Helper Ditto

Ditto can be Trozeid with any Pokémon. It appears just as other Pokémon; however, you can also make it appear when you line up more Pokémon than needed to get a Trozei—such as Trozei with 5 Pokémon when you can get a Trozei with 4 Pokémon.

You can also get a Trozei with all Ditto.



## ✦ Game Over

When the top and bottom screens are filled with Pokémon, the game is over. When the game is over, the message "Play Again?" will be displayed. If you want to challenge again, select "Yes." Select "No" if you would like to quit.



## Pokémon Vanish from the Field

Rare Pokémon will disappear from the field after a limited time. It's better to Trozei them as early as possible.







## Checking the Screen



- 1 **Remaining:** When the number of remaining Pokémon reaches zero, the stage is clear.
- 2 **Location, Stage/Level**
- 3 **Trozei List:** You can check how complete your Trozei List is.
- 4 **Playfield:** The area where you can touch and slide Pokémon.
- 5 **Score**
- 6 **Pokémon**
- 7 **Trozei Chance:** This is displayed for a limited time when Continuous Trozeis are counted.



- 8 **Trozei These?!** This shows rare Pokémon that may appear in the stage.

## Search PictoChat

If someone is using PictoChat around you when you open the Wireless Icon while playing Endless Trozei, or when you are on the invitation screen for Battle or Pair Trozei, the PictoChat Icon will be displayed on the screen. When you touch the icon, you are asked whether you would like to stop playing and turn the power off to use PictoChat. If you would like to stop, select "Yes."

★ When you close the Nintendo DS system while searching PictoChat, the search will be terminated.

# Trozei Adventure

## ✦ Story

The **Phobos Battalion** is an evil organization which uses **Lunatone** as its symbol. They have been stealing countless Poké Balls containing Pokémon and carrying them to their secret bases using various machines called Phobos Mobiles. Your mission is to rescue the stolen Pokémon from the Phobos Battalion!

There are two main characters in this story: the heroine **Lucy Fleetfoot** and **Professor P.** Both belong to a secret organization for justice named the Secret Operations League, or **SOL** for short.

Lucy also has two reliable assistants, **Aipom** and **Manectric**.

To rescue Pokémon, you'll need to use a gadget called the **Trozei Beamer**. You can scan Poké Balls and then transfer the Pokémon inside! However, an accurate lock is required for transfer.

To do this, you need to line up Poké Balls containing identical Pokémon in a straight line.



Can Lucy and Professor P Trozei the stolen Pokémon, thus rescuing them?

Will they be able to stop the plot of the Phobos Battalion and save the world?

## ✧ How to Progress

In Trozei Adventure, you can progress through the story by moving around on the map. You will start at the SOL Base. On the map you will find the Phobos Battalion's hideouts, storage facilities where they keep captured Pokémon, and so on. When you touch a storage facility, the conditions for that location are displayed on the top screen.

### Information

The number of Prize Coins you have and the number of locations you have cleared.



### SOL Satellite

An information satellite owned by SOL.

### Map Scroller

When you touch here, the map will scroll to the next area.



### SOL Base

This is where you start.

### Return

Returns you to the previous screen.

## ✧ Pause Menu

When you press START during the game, the pause menu will be displayed. Touch "Continue" to keep playing the game, or touch "Return to Map" to quit the area, then touch "Yes" to confirm.



## ✧ Stage Clear

Each stage has a certain amount of Pokémon you need to rescue. When you make it to zero, the stage is clear. You might be awarded a Clear Bonus after clearing a stage in Trozei Adventure.

### Remaining

The number of remaining Pokémon you need to rescue.



### Clear Bonus

You might be awarded this when you clear a stage.

## ✦ Prize Coins

When you clear a stage, a Prize Coin will be given to you if your score is more than the Prize Target.



## ✦ Mr. Who

You will be able to go to Mr. Who's stage as you proceed in the story. It's easier to Trozei rare Pokémon in this stage. However, you need a Prize Coin to play.



## ✦ Phobos Battalion's Stages

As you proceed in the story, you will encounter Generals of the Phobos Battalion. During your battles with them, they will try to block you out using many methods, such as Jammer Flashes or Jammer Balls. When the remaining Pokémon decrease, they will drop more Pokémon. To prevent them from dropping additional Pokémon, you will need to stun them with Continuous Trozeis.

If a General is stunned, this will be displayed.

A Jammer Ball can't be cleared unless you line it up with Ditto.



A Jammer Flash causes the Pokémon to turn to silhouettes. You can recover from this by getting a Trozei.





## Endless Trozei

### ✦ What is Endless Trozei?

This mode lets you keep playing to challenge your best score.

### ✦ How to Play

Select the starting level you would like to challenge first.



#### Level Setting

If you touch ► on the right, the level gets higher.  
If you touch ◀ on the left, the level gets lower.

### ✦ Pause Menu

When you press START during the game, the pause menu will be displayed. Touch "Continue" to keep playing the game, or touch "Retire" to quit the game, then touch "Yes" to confirm.



### ✦ Stage Level

When the number of remaining Pokémon reaches zero, you move to the next level.

## Trozei With Friends Nearby! (Friend Icon Panel)

The DS Wireless Communication feature searches for friends within range of your DS who are also communicating and allows you to challenge them. If you always have the Friend Icon Panel open while playing Endless Trozei, you will be communicating and can send or receive invitations for Trozei Battle and Pair Trozei.

- 1 When you touch the DS Wireless Icon while playing Endless Trozei, the Friend Icon Panel will open.



- 2 If you have friends around you who are communicating, a Friend Icon will be displayed on the Friend Icon Panel.



The Friend Icon

- 3 When you touch the Friend Icon, the screen to the right will be displayed.



- 4 The player who sends an invitation needs to touch Battle or Pair. After you touch one, the screen to the right will be displayed.



- 5 The player who receives the invitation should touch "Yes" or "No."

## Trozei Battle

### ✦ What Is Trozei Battle?

This is a battle mode for two players. You can battle with a friend who has Pokémon Trozei or with a friend who has downloaded Pokémon Trozei Mini (see page 36) using DS Wireless Communication within range of your DS.

### ✦ Preparation

#### ⚙ When two players have Pokémon Trozei

If each player has a Pokémon Trozei Game Card, please check DS Wireless Communication (DS Wireless Play) on page 45 to prepare.

#### ⚙ When your friend doesn't have Pokémon Trozei

If your friend doesn't have a Pokémon Trozei Game Card, they will need to download Pokémon Trozei Mini. Please distribute Pokémon Trozei Mini to your friend after reading page 46.

### ✦ How to Start

❶ Touch "Battle" on the menu screen. The Agent Icons will then be displayed.



👤 **Other Agents** ..... Changes the screen to show other Agents.

🎲 **Random Challenge** .... Selects your opponent randomly.

❷ Touch the Friend Icon of the friend you would like to challenge. The screen to the right will be displayed on the DS of the player who sent the invitation.



❸ The screen to the right will be displayed on the DS of the player who received the invitation. Press "Yes."



❹ Choose the following options, then touch "Confirm." The battle will then start.



**Pokémon Set**... You can select the Pokémon that will appear. If you touch "Change," a different set of Pokémon can be used.

**Handicap** ..... You can select the speed at which Pokémon drop down.



## ✦ How to Play

In Trozei Battle, the player whose field has been filled with Pokémon will lose. If you make numerous Trozeis during the battle, you can send Pokémon that are in your Pokémon set to your opponent's field.

## ⚙ What is an Agent Badge?

An Agent Badge describes the Agent's rank. If you meet a certain condition, you can play a promotion battle (allowing you to have your Agent rank promoted).

## Pair Trozei

### ✦ What is Pair Trozei?

This is a two-player mode in which you challenge the best score while cooperating with a friend within local wireless range of your DS. You can play with a friend who has Pokémon Trozei or has downloaded Pokémon Trozei Mini (see page 36) using DS Wireless Communication.

### ✦ Preparation





#### ✧ When two players have Pokémon Trozei

If each player has a Pokémon Trozei Game Card, please check DS Wireless Communication (DS Wireless Play) on page 45.

#### ✧ When your friend doesn't have Pokémon Trozei

If your friend doesn't have a Pokémon Trozei Game Card, they will need to download Pokémon Trozei Mini. Please distribute Pokémon Trozei Mini to your friend after reading page 46.

### ✦ How to Start

- 1 Touch "Pair" on the menu screen. The Agent Icons will then be displayed.
- 2 Then, touch the Friend Icon of the friend you would like to cooperate with. The screen to the right will be displayed on the DS of the player who sent the invitation.
- 3 The screen to the right will be displayed on the DS of the player who received the invitation. Press "Yes."
- 4 Touch "Confirm" after you set the handicap. Pair play will then start.  
**Handicap** ..... You can select the speed at which Pokémon drop down.

## ✦ How to Play

In Pair Trozei, you can challenge the best score while cooperating with a friend. The rules are the same as usual. However, the more Continuous Trozeis you make, the easier it is for your partner to get Trozeis because the number of types of Pokémon will decrease on their field. Also, Ditto, which appears when you line up more Pokémon than needed to get a Trozei, will drop on your partner's field instead of yours.

## Pokémon Trozei Mini

### ✦ What Is Pokémon Trozei Mini?

You can distribute a version of Pokémon Trozei with limited functions to friends who are within local wireless range of your DS. The person who has received Pokémon Trozei Mini will be able to play a trial version of Endless Trozei, Trozei Battle (see page 28), and Pair Trozei (see page 32).

### ✧ Battle using Pokémon Trozei Mini

You can do the following using Pokémon Trozei Mini.

Players	Battle	Pair
Full version x Mini	●	●
Mini x Mini	▲	▲

▲ is the version with limited functions.

### ✦ Preparation

Prepare for the download by following the instructions for Wireless Communication (DS Download Play) on page 46. The person who is sending the data should touch the Pokémon Trozei Mini distribution icon displayed on the menu in the Battle or Pair screen. By doing that, you can send the data to friends you would like to play with.

## Trozei List

### What is the Trozei List?

You can check Pokémon you have Trozeid so far, as well as details of each Pokémon.

#### Trozei List Completion

You can check the percentage of Pokémon you have rescued.

#### Trozei Locations

Locations where you can Trozei that Pokémon.

#### Already Trozeid Mark

This is displayed if you've rescued that Pokémon.

#### Sorting the List

You can sort the list in alphabetical or numerical order.



#### No.

Pokémon number and name. The Pokémon's name will not be displayed unless you have information on that Pokémon.

#### Pokémon

A Pokémon that has not been Trozeid is displayed as a silhouette.

#### Scroll Bar

Moving this up and down allows you to scroll through the list.

## Rescue All the Pokémon



As you proceed in Trozei Adventure, Professor P will sometimes give you information on where rare Pokémon are being held, saying, "We've located the Pokémon \_\_\_\_."

Check your Trozei List frequently to see how close you are to rescuing all the Pokémon. Try to rescue them all!

Playing with friends who have Pokémon Trozei and also distributing Pokémon Trozei Mini to many friends (and then playing with them) increases your chances of finding more rare Pokémon.





## Ranking Stats

### ✦ What Are the Ranking Stats?

When you play Trozei Battle or Pair Trozei with a friend who has Pokémon Trozei, both of your ranking stats are automatically shared with each other. The updated ranking data will be displayed the next time you visit the Ranking Stats section.



### ✦ Ranking Types

You can check the following records in the Ranking Stats section.

<b>Trozei List</b>	Completion percentage of Pokémon in your Trozei List.
<b>Continuous Trozei</b>	Records the highest number of Continuous Trozeis in Endless Trozei.
<b>Simultaneous Trozei</b>	Records the highest number of Simultaneous Trozeis in Endless Trozei.
<b>Endless Best Score</b>	Records the highest scores in Endless Trozei.
<b>???</b>	???
<b>Pair Best Score</b>	Records the highest scores in Pair Trozei.
<b>Overall</b>	You can check your overall records.

**Note:** In the Options menu, you can delete records from the Ranking Stats. Please see page 45 for more information.





## Agent Cafe

### Agent Cafe (Tag Mode)

You can use Tag Mode with other Pokémon Trozei players using DS Wireless Communication. Tag Mode automatically communicates when you pass by another player who is also using Tag Mode. In Pokémon Trozei, this is called Espionage. If you pass by another player while you both are in Espionage Mode, your Agent Cards will be exchanged.

**Note:** When you exchange Agent Cards with another player, your birthday (month and day, not year), nickname, gender (if not set to secret), and personal message will be shared with that player. If you do not enter this information in Pokémon Trozei, the default information you entered in your Nintendo DS will be used instead.

#### Agent Card Collection

(Other players' information that you collected using Espionage)

You can check the Agent Cards of players you have communicated with.

#### Espionage

You can use Tag Mode with other players.

#### Your Agent Card

You can edit your Agent Card (see page 44).



You can get information about rare Pokémon from some Agent Cards. You can also check the following records on an Agent Card.

#### 1 Nickname

Nickname of the card's owner.

#### 2 Gender

Gender of the card's owner. This is displayed as long as it's not set to "Secret."

#### 3 Date of Birth

The date of birth registered in the Nintendo DS system will be displayed.

#### 4 Map Picture

You can get information about a rare Pokémon's location. You can play the stage by touching it.

#### 5 Edit

You can edit your nickname, gender, and personal message on your Agent Card (see page 44).

**Note:** While viewing your Agent Card Collection, you can delete another player's Agent Card by touching the garbage can icon, then touching "Yes" to confirm.





## Options

You can set the following options.

### ● Nickname

You can change your nickname if you touch "Edit."

### ● Gender

Touch the male or female symbols if you would like to reveal your gender. If not, touch "Secret."

### ● Message

You can input a simple personal message. See the following for how to input it. Input a character by touching the keyboard displayed on the screen. Touch "Confirm" to finish.

### How to use the keyboard

Change the input mode from Alphabetic to Japanese Hiragana, International, symbols, or pictures.

Shift between capitals/symbols and lowercase letters/numbers.



Switch to capital letters.

Backspace or erase a character.

Add a space.

### Writing Hand

You can set your writing hand. If you use your right hand, touch "Right." If you use your left hand, touch "Left."

### PictoChat Search Feature

You can choose to turn the PictoChat Search feature on or off. When turned on, if you open the Wireless Icon (see page 15) in Endless Trozei, or are on the Battle or Pair Trozei invitation screen, this feature searches out players who are using PictoChat around you.

### Resetting the Adventure

You can restart the adventure from the beginning. Trozei List and Ranking Stats data is not erased. Touch "Reset" if you would like to restart.

### Reset Ranking Stats

You can delete Ranking Stats records, either individually or all together. However, you can only delete or reset records that have been transferred to you. You cannot individually delete or reset your own records. Please follow the instructions on the screen.

### Steps for guests

1. Turn on the power of the system. The DS menu screen will appear.
2. Touch the "DS Download Play" panel. The game-selection screen will appear.
3. Touch the "Pokémon Trozei" panel. The game-confirmation screen will appear.
4. When the correct software appears, touch "Yes." P1 (host) will start the download process.
5. Please follow the instructions on page 29 and 33.

## Wireless Communication Guidelines:

During wireless game play, an icon will appear on either the upper or lower displays showing the signal strength of the wireless signal. The icon has four modes depending on the signal strength, as shown below.

- Begin with the distance between systems at about 30 feet or less and move closer or farther apart as desired, keeping the signal strength at two or more bars for best results.
- Keep the maximum distance between systems at 65 feet or less.
